

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.
ASSOCIATION NOT FOR PECUNIARY PROFIT.

The undersigned; R.E. Saker, M. Matthews, H.R. Gluth, R. Tweedle, Arthur Tweedle, Elwood Lamberg, M.G. Sternberg, Carl Gragg, Rudolph Holtz, and Wm. J. Voss, all of the County of Lake, State of Indiana, desiring to associate themselves for a lawful purpose other than pecuniary profit, as hereinafter stated, under an act of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, approved March 6, 1889.

1. The name and title by which such corporation is to be known in law is; South Shore Improvement Association.
2. The purpose for which it is formed is; For the development of a closer bond of good fellowship and comradeship between the members of this Association. To take over, improve and control the beach adjoining the South Shore Sub-division known as Lot A. To provide funds for the improving of the beach, roads, or any other part of the Sub-division. To act as a body in all matters pertaining to the welfare of the lot owners in the South Shore Sub-division and to provide funds in such matters, provided, however, that this association is not to be operated for profit, either for the association or an individual member. That the beach belongs to the association and cannot be sold and cannot be used for any purpose whatsoever except for the benefit of the lot owners.
3. The place where such corporation is to be located and where its business is to be conducted is in the Village of Cedar Lake, in the County of Lake, and State of Indiana.
4. The number of Trustees shall be Ten and the names of the Trustees selected for the first year of its existence are; Arthur Tweedle, Elwood Lamberg, E.W. Laughren, M. G. Sternberg, H. S. Donnelly, Carl Gragg, Alexander Bell, Rudolph Holtz, and Wm. J. Voss all of Lake County, State of Indiana.

5. The corporation may maintain an office or offices at such place or places out side the State Of Indiana as may be determined by the Trustees, where meetings of the Trustees may be hold and business may be transacted by the Trustees, officers and agents of the corporation.

6. The said corporation shall maintain an office at Cedar Lake, in the County of Lake, in the State of Indiana, with a resident agent in charge thereof during business hours, upon whom process against said corporation may be served.
